

# Please Note!



As more and more patients return to the 3001 Highland office building for their care, we have the following policies in place.

- Masks must be worn in the public areas of the building. If you don't have a mask with you, please ask any of the office staff who can provide one.
- You are encouraged to use hand sanitizer upon your arrival. This is available in the atrium or in the waiting rooms.
- Please do not enter the building if you have any symptoms of Covid-19. These include, but are not limited to, fever/body aches, cough/sore throat, shortness of breath, headache and loss of taste or smell.
- We ask that you come alone to your appointment unless you need someone to accompany you for their help.
- Clinicians may continue to request that you wait in your vehicle until they notify you that they are ready for you at which point they will meet you at the door or in the waiting room as directed.
- The waiting rooms are available. If you use them, please do not come early. Clinicians will make every effort to take you promptly when you have pushed their light. If the waiting room is more crowded than you would like, it is acceptable to push the light and wait in the atrium. Family members may not remain in the waiting room while someone is being seen. Please give your clinician contact information for them so they may return if necessary when your session is completed.
