



Thank you for your interest in the scholarship program at Women Writing for (a) Change. We hope the following information will help you decide if requesting a scholarship for classes at Women Writing for (a) Change is right for you at this time.

The WWf(a)C scholarship program was established in 1999 to reduce financial barriers that prevent women, girls, and men from participating in the WWf(a)C community of writers, particularly those of race, culture, class and age.

Scholarship funds help pay WWf(a)C tuition fees of eligible women, girls, and men. Eligibility is based on two factors: 1) the applicant's financial need and 2) her / his commitment to "being present" throughout the course, including regular attendance, in order to benefit from, and be an asset to the program. Scholarship requests are considered in the order received. If we cannot fund all applications within a given semester we attempt to distribute funds to assist those in the greatest financial need. Our priority is to assist women, girls, or men who could not attend without financial help.

- \$25 deposit
- written responses to the application questions
- documentation of income

Your deposit will be returned to you if we cannot grant your scholarship request. Information you provide about your financial circumstances will be kept confidential. We appreciate your interest, and look forward to receiving your application.
